
ORDER ADOPTING REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

Having reviewed Magistrate Judge Mark J. Dinsmore’s Report and Recommendation that Kiley Clardy’s supervised release be modified, pursuant to Title 18, U.S.C. §3401(i) and Rule 32.1(a)(1) *Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure* and Title 18 U.S.C. §3583, The Court now approves and adopts the Report and Recommendation as the entry of the Court, and orders that the conditions of Kiley Clardy’s supervised release should be **MODIFIED** as follows:

1. The defendant shall participate in a cognitive behavioral program, such as Moral Reconciliation Therapy (MRT), at the direction of the probation officer and abide by the rules of the program.
2. The defendant shall not consume alcohol during the remaining period of his supervised release.
